

Catholicism Is The Only True Church?

On Wednesday, July 10th, the Pope issued a statement which reasserted the universal primacy of the Roman Catholic Church. In this statement, he said that other Christian denominations were not true churches. The document stated, "Christ established here on earth only one church.... The other communities cannot be called churches in the proper sense because they do not have apostolic succession -- the ability to trace their bishops back to Christ's original apostles."
